



# Indo-U.S. Genome Engineering/Editing Technology Initiative (GETin) Visiting Fellowship Program Guidelines

Acknowledging importance of strategies & techniques in genome modification, as modern day essential tools for research & development, the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Govt. of India along with the Indo-U.S. Science & Technology Forum (IUSSTF) announces fellowship program between Indian institutes and premier U.S. Universities, in significant areas of Genome Engineering/Editing Technology (*GETin*).

The program is open to individuals whose research work has an interface with Genome Engineering/Editing Technology studies.

#### **PROGRAM OBJECTIVE:**

- 1. Program aims at inviting skilled researchers (US Faculty/Foreign Post Docs presently working in U.S. for at least two years) to India, who is working overseas in the cutting-edge area of Genome Engineering/Editing Technologies.
- 2. Program would provide the applicant avenues to pursue their R&D interests in Indian institutions/and to mentor Indian scientist(s) in their projects.
- 3. Promote research and capacity building in the frontline area of Genome Engineering/Editing Technology;
- 4. Pave way for the next generation scientists and technologists from the U.S. to interact with Indian peers, thus helping to build long-term R&D linkages and collaborations.

#### **MODULE:**

#### A. Genome Engineering/Editing Technology (GETin) Visiting Fellowship

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY:

- 1. U.S. Faculty or Foreign Post-Docs presently working in U.S. (for at least two years) in a field having an interface with Genome Engineering/Editing Technologies.
- 2. Applicant should possess Ph.D., M.D., M.S. or equivalent degree with outstanding track record as evident though publications and other recognitions.
- 3. Only candidates working overseas for at least two years are eligible to apply.
- 4. Age: Up to 60 years as on 31st December 2018

#### **DURATION AND NUMBER OF AWARDS:**

- 1. The duration of fellowship will include work at India Universities for a period of **2 to 3** months.
- 2. Up to **5 Visiting Fellows** will be awarded every year.

#### **NATURE OF SUPPORT:**

- 1. Monthly remuneration of Rs. 1, 50,000 per month
- 2. Return air fare
- 3. Grant of Rs. 5,00,000/- would be provided to the host institute in India to support the research during stay period.
- 4. Health insurance of up to US \$1,000 during the entire stay.
- 5. One-time contingency grant of up to US \$1,000.

(Conversion from US\$ to INR will be as per the prevailing foreign exchange rates)

#### **WHERE WILL AWARDEES WORK:**

- 1. The candidate should himself/herself correspond with their proposed host institute in India for placement/visit.
- 2. Any Indian Institute can also identify any such skilled research in this field, so that his/her expertise can be benefited and the institute can assist the overseas researcher to apply accordingly.
- 3. Candidate is required to produce a letter of acceptance/ Certificate from the Indian Institute along with merits/uniqueness of that host institute in the proposed area of research.
- 4. There should be willingness in the part of the Indian institute to accept and extend necessary support to the candidate for the work proposed during the stay period.

#### **HOW TO APPLY:**

Application should be submitted using our Online Application Portal by **30**<sup>th</sup> **September 2018**, weblink provided on IUSSTF website **www.iusstf.org**, along with the following documents:

- Acceptance Letter/ Certificate from host institute in the India, , as per the format indicated\*
- Two recommendation letters from Referees
- No-Objection Certificate/ Statement from the Current Employer, as per the format indicated\*\*
- Scan copy of the highest degree obtained by the applicant
- CV of the Indian Host (not more than 3 pages)
- CV of the applicant with current photo (not more than 3 pages)
- Proof of DoB (Scan copy of the supporting document, e.g. Birth certificate/ 10<sup>th</sup> Class certificate/ passport)

## \* ACCEPTANCE LETTER/ CERTIFICATE BY THE HOST INSTITUTE
