<u>Three Intel ISEF Finalists Awarded the</u> <u>Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar 2019</u>

Of these, four students are winners of the Intel & DST led Initiative for Research and Innovation in Science (IRIS) National Fair and were part of Team India to Intel IRIS 2018
